1. Rate each study 1-7 on the following domains:

Scientific merit

- *How important is the study or experimental question?*
- How well is this based in the existing literature?
- Is there a need to know the answer to the study question?

Originality

- *How novel is the idea?*
- If it has been done before, does this study seek to expand on existing knowledge or is it simply doing the same study in a different country/region etc.?

Methodology

- *What is the quality of the study or experimental design? For example: RCT versus uncontrolled case series; experiment with positive and negative controls etc.*
- Is the methodology actually executed well and is it robust?
- How well does the design address the study or experimental question?
- Are statistics used appropriately or are there fundamental errors such as using the mean for skewed distributions?

Applicability to clinical practice

- *Is this study useful to clinicians?*
- If not immediately useful, could it lead to a significant scientific finding or breakthrough, or further work?

Presentation

- *Has the study been published?*
- *Is the entrant the first author?*
- How well is the study written?
- How clearly are ideas, results and diagrams presented?

Maximum score is 35. Items in red italics should be given more weight.
