## The ENTSHO.COM Prize 2023 Regulations & Information for Entrants

The prize:	1) Prize certificate for your portfolio; 2) One free place on an entsho.com/ <i>ExcellENT</i> craft course; 3) £150 towards conference or meeting attendance (receipts needed).
Open to:	Junior grade doctors (F1-CT3 including SHO-grade fellows but no registrar- or consultant-grade doctors) who hold a licence to practise medicine in the United Kingdom or Republic of Ireland, who are within five years of obtaining their primary medical qualification. Full-time military junior doctors may discount up to two years for basic training and general duties time.
How to enter:	The prize is for the study that contributes most to evidence-based ENT clinical practice.
	<b>1. a)</b> Each entrant can submit one paper for consideration. The entrant may be the primary author or a co-author although first authorship will carry more weight with the judges. Different authors cannot submit the same paper.
	<b>b)</b> The manuscript must be in the form of an academic paper, although it can be unpublished at the time of submission.
	<b>c)</b> Entrants should provide their paper in PDF format.
	For published (typset) manuscripts or accepted author manuscripts (not typeset), the final published PDF is sufficient, regardless of length. Accepted author manuscripts should be accompanied by an editor's email acceptance.
	For unpublished manuscripts, the main body of text should follow <i>Clinical Otolaryngology</i> submission guidelines – Text must not exceed 3000 words. The manuscript should be arranged as: Title; Authors; Abstract; Introduction; Method (including Study Design and Ethical Considerations); Results; Discussion; Conclusions; References. The text should be set in Cambria or Times New Roman size 10, single line spacing. Entrants should also provide any supplementary figures and appendices as separate files.
	<b>d)</b> Most studies, including systematic reviews, clinical trials, case-control studies, large case series and large closed-loop audits are eligible. Abstracts of conference presentations, single cycle audits and comment letters are not eligible.
	<b>e)</b> We will not consider incomplete submissions or those not conforming to the conditions above. The Editor's decision on eligibility is final and such a decision may not be made until after the submission deadline has passed.

	<b>3.</b> Entrants should then go to <i>entsho.com/prize-submissions</i> and follow the stepwise instructions for submission.
